



CRAFT/ACTIVITY: CHILDREN OF THE WORLD MOBILES

Students will make a mobile of the world representing diverse ethnicities. This will help children remember that Jesus loves all the children of the world.

MATERIALS

1. White 67 lb. Cardstock
2. Children of the World Mobile Pattern
3. Hole Punch
4. Yarn
5. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils
6. Scissors



DIRECTIONS

1. Copy a “Children of the World Mobile Pattern” for each student on 67 lb. Cardstock.
2. Have students color the world and children with crayons, markers, or colored pencils.
3. Allow students to cut out each piece of the mobile.
4. Help students punch holes in each piece of the mobile.
5. Tie small pieces of yarn from the world to each of the children.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their mobiles, remind them of how Jesus loved the children so much that he told his disciples to let the children come to him. Help students understand that Jesus used this opportunity to teach his disciples that entering the kingdom of God means accepting God’s truths and his Son through faith. Children are most responsive to the idea of truly believe in something they cannot see (which is the definition of faith). Much like they believe in Santa Claus, the Tooth Fairy, or the Easter Bunny, children have little difficulty believing in God. This story illustrates how adults should believe like children.



CHILDREN OF THE WORLD MOBILE PATTERN


CHILDREN OF THE WORLD MOBILE PATTERN





Have You Ever Sinned?

PRESCHOOL GAME

Supplies: None

This game will help children know how much Jesus loved little children.

Say: One day Jesus had many little children come to him. Some of the older people, called disciples, didn't like the little children getting so close, but Jesus loved the little children.

Get the children into a circle with one person acting as Jesus in the middle. Use more than one circle if you have more than six preschoolers. Have them hold hands and stretch their circle out until their arms are extended.

Have the children walk in a circle around Jesus as they sing this song to the tune of "Have You Ever Seen a Lassie?":

Have you ever seen Jesus,

Seen Jesus, seen Jesus;

Have you ever seen Jesus

Turn children away?

He loves us (*walk in close to Jesus*),

We love him (*take backward steps to enlarge the circle*),

He loves us (*walk in close to Jesus*),

We love him. (*Take backward steps to enlarge the circle.*)

Have you ever seen Jesus (*walk in a circle around Jesus again*)

Turn children away?

When children come into the center of the circle, they can gently give Jesus a hug. Let Jesus pick another child to be in the center to continue play.
